## CYE Sailing Centre Bursary Fund

Application Form for beneficiaries for young person, under 25

If a young person is unable to attend a CYE event or residential visit **because of financial hardship**, then their parent, guardian, carer or teacher may apply to the Christian Youth Enterprises Bursary Fund for financial assistance towards the cost of the CYE visit.

As with all charities, funds are limited. The income available to support the Bursary Fund depends upon donations received and as such the fund will only be able to support a limited number of applications each year. The applicant will normally be expected to contribute at least 60% of the cost of the event. A small administration team, working with and on behalf of the CYESC Trustees, considers each application. Decisions made by this team are final. There is no appeal process.

Note: the "Counter Signature" section of this form <u>must</u> be completed. We cannot consider any application that is not endorsed and counter-signed by an appropriate person.

Applications are usually made by the young person's parent, guardian or carer. If there is an exceptional reason, such as speaking English as an additional language, the application may be completed by someone else, such as a teacher or pastor.

Your feedback is valuable in helping us to maintain the fund and in reporting back to our donors. Therefore, a condition of receiving an award will be that you complete a simple questionnaire about the impact that the award has made for the young person. We will use this to report back to those who have donated to the fund, and to help promote future donations. We will contact you for your feedback after the event.
